What are apprenticeships?

What do they involve?

Each apprenticeship involves a structured programme of training. Whilst in work you'll work as an employee alongside experienced staff members. Off the job you'll learn with Newcastle College through a combination of learning methods that may include a day in college, online assessments or assessments within your workplace.

To secure an apprenticeship you will also have to secure a job within an organisation.

How to get your apprenticeship To apply for an apprenticeship with Newcastle College, you would need to have the following:

- CV
- Proof of the required qualification
- GCSE Grade 3-/-D in English and maths (Level 2 Apprenticeships)
- GCSE Grade 4-/-C in English and maths (Level 3 Apprenticeships)

You would also need to complete an initial assessment. We ask for your CV and proof of grades before sitting the assessment, which takes around 15 minutes to complete over the phone.

You can apply for an apprenticeship through the National Apprenticeship services website, which includes all apprenticeship vacancies throughout England.
